UW to dedicate new Medal of Honor Memorial

The University of Washington is pleased to invite all active, Reserve and retired members of the U.S. armed forces community to our campus on Veterans Day, November 11, 2009. The UW will celebrate Veterans Day with a parade and special ceremony to dedicate the new UW Medal of Honor Memorial.

Designed by a two artists and a landscape architect, the memorial recognizes all 3,467 Medal recipients and specifically the eight UW alumni who hold the award. The UW is proud to have more Medal of Honor recipients among its alumni than any other public university in the country except the service academies.

WHEN: Veterans Day, November 11, 2009

WHERE: At the Medal of Honor memorial. It occupies the circle between Memorial Way, which begins at the Northeast 45th Street entrance to campus, and the university flagpole, which bears the names of UW community members killed in World War II.

TIME: Parade begins at 10:00 a.m., ceremony at 10:30 a.m.

We invite representatives of military groups, active and retired, to be part of the Veterans Day parade and then remain for the dedication.
